

2014-2015 Career and Technical Education High School Student Scholarships Award Application

The Clarksville-Montgomery County Education Foundation supports education in many ways. One focus of the Education Foundation is to provide competitive post-secondary scholarships to students in Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs, including our Academies of CMCSS as incentive to continue their education beyond high school. The one-time scholarships are designed for CTE and Academy students (once seniors) and funded by the generous support of the Clarksville-Montgomery County business community and individuals.

- The scholarship selection committee will be representatives of the Education Foundation Board of Directors.
- It is the intent of the Foundation to consider scholarship awards on a district-wide competitive basis.

2014-2015 Awards Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Student applicants must have proficiently completed three CTE credits in the same program area.
- 2. Scholarship awardees must have a **3.0** in program area courses.
- 3. **Character** Two letters of recommendation; 1 from CTE program teacher and 1 from a community member.
- 4. **Leadership** Student must have actively participated in program specific CTSO for a minimum of 2 years. Student will obtain documentation of membership and attach to this application. Documentation can be copies of CTSO affiliation or competition registration, CTSO newsletters, pictures of student actively involved in CTSO activities and/or school or local newspaper articles.
- Community Service Students must provide proof of at least 5 hours of community service completed during the application year. This can be verified through letter from CTSO Adviser, Adviser from other school organizations such as NHS, NTHS and FCA, Youth Group Pastor or Organizer and/or Civic Group Representative/s.
- 6. Student applicants must have plans to attend an accredited post-secondary institution such as a Tennessee College of Applied Technology, Community College or 4 year college or university.
- All applicants must include the checklist as the first page of the submitted application with all requested items checked off. All pages should also be in a 3- prong folder as a package in checklist order.
 Applications not in this format will be returned and no consideration will be given to the applicant. No Binders please!

Deadline for Filing Application: Complete all items and return to your CTE teacher before the deadline. Scholarship applications are due to the Career and Technical Education Coordinator, Karen Pitts no later than March 23, 2015.

No late applications will be accepted. Selections will be made by April 24, 2015.
